On 08/22/2015 I responded to 110 N. Neil in reference to a robbery call. [REDACTED] called 911 and said she was just mugged. [REDACTED] advised that it was a white male 5'10" brown hair and hazel eyes. Upon my arrival, I was operating marked squad 51 and my in car video was activated.

I spoke with Jennifer outside of the Quality Bar. [REDACTED] told me that she was robbed in the parking lot of Busey Bank. [REDACTED] told me that she was walking to her vehicle that was parked in the northeast area of the Busey Bank parking lot. As she was walking to her vehicle, [REDACTED] noticed a white male. [REDACTED] was starting to open the vehicle door and the same male walked up to her. [REDACTED] stated that the male came up to her and pulled her purse. [REDACTED] had it on her arm.

When the male pulled her purse, [REDACTED] pulled back. The male then pulled back and got the purse away from [REDACTED]. As he was pulling the purse away, [REDACTED] grabbed her small make-up bag out of the purse along with her i.d. Sometime during the struggle, [REDACTED] said that she kicked the male "in the nuts." [REDACTED] said that the male ran away.

[REDACTED] then drove her vehicle to the other side of the parking lot and ran into the Quality bar to call 911. [REDACTED] described the male as 5'7" brown hair black shirt and jeans. [REDACTED] said that the male ran east on Park and then north on Neil St.

[REDACTED] said that her purse was a brown Italian leather purse. Stolen from the purse was her dad's credit card ([REDACTED]), her eye glasses, and her hot pink IPHONE 5C.

Please see Sergeant Thompson's supplement regarding the show up.


I took [REDACTED] home and went inside her apartment to try and track her IPHONE. We were unable to track the IPHONE.

NARRATIVE

On 08/22/2015, at approximately 0146 hours, I was acting as the North District shift supervisor for the midnight shift. I was operating fully marked squad #35, and I was wearing a full Champaign Police Uniform. At this time, METCAD advised of a robbery that just occurred at the Busey Bank lot located at 100 West University. I attempted to let the dispatch know that I was currently at that location, however I could not get on the air. Eventually, I was able to advise that I was on scene. Initially METCAD stated that the victim was at the Quality Bar, however I could not locate her. METCAD stated that the suspect description was a white male, hazel eyes, last seen wearing a black shirt and blue jeans with brown hair. I then saw a male walking on the west side of Neil approaching the Busey lot. I noted that he was a white male, with brown hair, and that he was wearing a black shirt and blue jean. My attention was drawn to this male because as he saw me, he turned his head and shoulders slightly away and hurried his pace. He was walking southbound. I then crossed the street and walked into the Busey lot.

At first, I didn't see where the male went. I then heard a vehicle start, and saw the same male, driving away in a black Honda Civic bearing an Illinois registration starting with "X63." I immediately radioed officers to see if there was anyone in the area. I shined my flashlight directly at the driver of the vehicle, and he ignored me. The male, later identified as Christopher, continued out of the parking lot ignoring me

attempting to catch up to him. He continued eastbound on University.

Lt. Clark (926) asked me if it was a Honda Civic that was the vehicle I called out. I confirmed to him that it was and he conducted a stop on the vehicle. (See his supplemental for details of that stop) I then returned to Quality Bar to speak with the victim, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] was animated and upset over the incident. She advised me that this was the third time that she had been robbed since living in the Champaign-Urbana area. She stated that she was at V. Picasso, and later went over to Quality Bar to meet up with a friend. She left and walked to her vehicle in the Busey parking lot. She stated that she immediately noticed a white male looking at her and she became concerned. She tried to elude him and walk a different route and entered her vehicle. She then turned around to see the male standing directly next to her while she was inside her vehicle. She said that the male, Christopher, grabbed her purse and attempted to rip it from her person. [REDACTED] stated that she tried to grab her purse back, however she was overpowered. She told Christopher to "Fuck off," and "Fuck you," and kicked him in the groin area. She stated she was happy with herself for being able to kick him to defend herself, and that she was angry that this happened to her. I told her that she did a great job keeping calm enough to respond and provide a description. I next transported [REDACTED] from the Busey lot to the stop that Lt. Clark conducted for a show up. Upon arrival, officers had Christopher step out of the squad car. [REDACTED] shouted "Bingo!" "That's him!" She also shouted that she was 100% certain and again told Christopher "Fuck you!" This positive identification was made at 0200 hours. [REDACTED] thanked the officers profusely that stopped Christopher. He was transported to the Champaign County Jail by Officer Buckley. I then transported [REDACTED] back to the Busey lot. Officer Epling spoke with her and transported her home.

NARRATIVE

THIS IS A SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT TO OFFICER EPLING'S ORIGINAL REPORT.

On 08/22/2015, I was assigned the South patrol district of Champaign. On that date, I was operating in squad #31.

At 0146 hours, Lieutenant Clark #926 initiated a terry stop on a vehicle that matched the description of a male involved in a robbery. I was close to the final stop location. As I pulled up to the terry stop, Officer Buckley advised they could use another unit at the terry stop. I advised METCAD that I was on scene.

I approached the vehicle and observed Lieutenant Clark speaking to a white male driver in a black Honda Civic bearing Illinois registration of X632713. I made it to the driver side of the vehicle and heard Lieutenant Clark speaking to the driver, later identified as Chris. Lieutenant Clark instructed Chris to open the vehicle. I later learned that Chris had been instructed to open the door several times before I arrived on scene. Lieutenant Clark warned the Chris that if he didn't open the door, he would shatter the window to gain entry to the vehicle. I did not hear Chris mention anything about opening the door. I then observed Lieutenant Clark grab the driver window with his hands and pull the window towards him. Lieutenant Clark broke the window allowing us access to the inside of the vehicle. Lieutenant Clark then unlocked the door by reaching inside the vehicle. I then opened the door by way of the door handle on the outside of the vehicle. I then grabbed Chris' left arm. While in control of his left arm, I reached into the vehicle and unbuckled him. After he was unbuckled, I then pulled him out of

the vehicle. After he was out of the vehicle, Officer Buckley assisted with getting him towards the rear of the car and securing him into handcuffs. When I pulled Chris out of the vehicle, I pivoted 180 degrees placing in against the trunk of the vehicle. I then placed him into handcuffs. I double locked them and checked for proper fit. Officer Buckley and I transported him to the back of Officer Buckley's squad car.

It should be noted that the reason Chris was pulled out from the vehicle was he was leaving the area of robbery that had just occurred. I gained control of Chris' left arm to keep control of him from running or putting myself in danger. The effectiveness of my arm control was successful by getting Chris into handcuffs without incident. Chris later complained of having glass in his eye but was seen by an ambulance on scene before being transported to CCSO. It was unknown if there was any pre-existing injuries to Chris. Chris was given several verbal commands to open the door and step out; he refused to get out of the vehicle. There were no injuries to any of the officers on scene that I am aware of. It was believed that Chris was under the influence of alcohol but was never offered a breath test or standardized field sobriety tests. I am aware of a positive show up for Chris, but do not know the name of the victim.

NARRATIVE

On 08/22/2015 I (Lt. Jim Clark).was working as the midnight shift watch commander for the Champaign Police Department. I was dressed in a class "c" police uniform and wearing an external vest carrier with a badge displayed over the left breast. I was driving my semi-marked squad car.

At approximately 1:46 AM officers were dispatched to a robbery that had just occurred near the Quality Bar at 110 N. Neil. The dispatch indicated that a female had came into the bar indicating that she was just robbed and had her purse stolen. The suspect was described as a white male, about 5'10" tall with brown hair and hazel eyes. He was wearing jeans and a black shirt and was last seen running northbound on Neil Street.

I started driving toward the downtown area from campus. I then

heard Sgt. Thompson advised that she observed a male fitting the description getting into a black Honda Civic. She advised the vehicle was pulling out of the Busey Bank parking lot and was going east on University Ave and asked if any units were in the area. She also dispatched a partial license plate of X63. As she dispatched this information I was northbound on Walnut at approximately Logan Street. I asked Sgt. Thompson where the vehicle was and she indicated that it was just driving by the Inman at Walnut and University. At that time I observed two vehicles drive eastbound on University and one of them was a black car. I turned east on University from Walnut and caught up to the black vehicle at University and First Street. I observed that it was a black Honda Civic and the licence plate was X632713.

The vehicle turned south on First Street and I advised METCAD that I would be making a terry stop on the vehicle at First and Springfield. The vehicle stopped at a red light at First and Springfield and then proceeded to turn east once the light turned green. I activated my emergency lights and the vehicle stopped in front of 107 E. Springfield at 1:51 AM.

I approached the drivers side of the vehicle and observed that the only occupant of the vehicle was a white male driver, later identified as Christopher Hansen. Christopher had the drivers window rolled down approximately 1/2 of an inch. I observed that he was wearing blue jeans and a black t-shirt. I asked Christopher to roll the window down further so I could speak with him and he said "I can hear you just fine". I asked him again to roll the window down and he responded that he wanted to speak with a supervisor. I informed him that I was the supervisor on duty and that he needed to roll the window down, however he continued to refuse to roll the window down. I then ordered Christopher to exit the car and explained that he was the subject of a traffic stop and I had the right to order him out of the car. Christopher continued to disobey my orders. I told him that if he did not exit the car that I would shatter

the window and he would be removed from the car. I ordered Christopher at least three times to exit the car or I would break the window. I tried the drivers side door and it was locked and Officer Buckley had tried the passenger side door and it was also locked.

I then told Christopher again that he needed to exit the car or I would break the window and he again refused to exit the car. I then grabbed the top of the window and pulled out until the window shattered. I reached inside the vehicle and unlocked the drivers door, at which point Officer Tatum and other officers removed Christopher from the vehicle and placed him in handcuffs, searched him and placed him in a squad car.

It should be noted that Christopher was wearing blue jeans and a black t-shirt at the time of the stop. These items were later seized by Officer Epling at the Champaign County Jail. The physical identifiers on Christopher's drivers license indicated that he was 6'00 tall, 230 pounds, had black hair and hazel eyes.

Once Christopher was secured, Sgt. Thompson brought the victim to the scene of the stop to conduct a show-up. Christopher was removed from the back seat of Officer Buckley's squad car and the victim positively identified Christopher as the person who had robbed her. This show up occurred at 2:00 AM which was 14 minutes after the call was initially dispatched. Sgt. Thompson later told me that the victim indicated that she was 100% sure that Christopher was the person who had robbed her. (See Sgt. Thompson's supplemental report for additional information regarding the show up.)

Christopher was transported to the Champaign County Jail by Officer Buckley and charged with Robbery and Resisting/Obstructing a Peace Officer.

I cleared the scene of the stop and returned to the scene of the

robbery and assisted Sgt. Thompson and Officer Epling in attempting to locate the victims purse. I searched the area of 100 N. Neil Street but was unable to locate the purse.

This ends my involvement in this incident.

NARRATIVE

On 08/22/15 at 0147 hrs, I was dispatched to Quality Bar (110 N. Neil St) to respond to a robbery that just occurred. METCAD advised a female had just been robbed. While en route to the call, Sgt Thompson radioed that a black Honda Civic needed to be stopped reference this call.

I was behind Lt. Clark when he initiated a traffic stop on the black Honda Civic, LIC: X632713, near the intersection of First/Springfield. I approached the vehicle on the passenger side while Lt. Clark spoke with the driver, Christopher. As the stop unfolded, Christopher refused to comply with Lt. Clark's order to exit the vehicle. For further on this aspect of the incident, see Lt. Clark's report.

I assisted Officer Tatum with Christopher's arrest and he was searched next to his vehicle. Christopher was then placed in the backseat of my vehicle at which point he requested medical attention for glass that was in his shoe. Medical personnel arrived on scene a short time later and evaluated Christopher. A small piece of glass was removed from Christopher's right shoe. Christopher then complained that his wrists hurt, however, it should be noted his handcuffs appeared to be on his wrists properly and were double locked.

Christopher was issued a medical refusal form at the scene. I attempted to obtain a statement from Christopher as he was seated in the backseat of my squad car. He refused to provide me with a statement, at which point he was transported to CCSO satellite jail.
