All I can say is that we would review the additional report for charges, and evaluate it based on the strength of the evidence that she willfully came up with a false report - as opposed to and weighed against any claim she could/would/will make in her defense that her misidentification was an 'honest mistake' made due to inebriation or some other factor(s). We'd have to be able to prove the requisite culpable mental state (beyond a reasonable doubt), not just establish that she was wrong.

So, the problems caused by her false report are/were certainly serious, but I can't commit the office to a position without seeing the available evidence first. How you want to proceed is up to you.
